Welcome to NCSA's 30th Season!

When NCSA began in 1994, there were 5 senior coaches, 4 junior coaches, and 8 board members (4 from Airdrie and 4 from Calgary).

There were 60 competitive swimmers and 25 in our learn to swim program (total of 80 athletes) this is when the Airdrie Swim Club (ASC) and Thornhill Thunderbolts (TTSC) amalgamated into the Nose Creek Swim Association. Back then we trained just out of our 2 home pools, Airdrie Genesis Place (which only had a dive tank, tot pool and the same 6 lanes) and Thornhill Aquatic Centre. In 1994, NCSA had 2 coaches.

This season we have 4 executive board members, 4 directors at large, 12 senior coaches, 15 junior coaches, 1 bookkeeper, and a team manager.

Currently in the water we have 169 competitive athletes and 202 in our NCSS learn to swim program (total of 371). We now train out of 5 pools and are always looking for more space.

We are excited to come together to make our 30th Season a huge success on every level, from swimmer performance to team unity, and to add to NCSA's rich poolside history!

Donations can be dropped off in bags/boxes CLEARLY labeled with the team's name. If possible, please wait for the bottles to be counted and let the attendant know it is for the NCSA bottle drop account; you will need to take a picture of the receipt as they do not issue one to the customer. Email the receipt to ncsa.fundraising@ncsaswim.ca with the subject line "NCSA bottle donations". This helps us to track donations and ensure all funds end up in the intended place.

IF YOUR DONATION IS GOING TOWARDS THE MANDATORY BOND FOR NOT ATTENDING REQUIRED BOTTLE DRIVES (both drives for NCSA & one drive for NCSS per family); YOU MUST ALSO TRACK YOUR DONATIONS AND SEND A SEPARATE EMAIL WITH ALL APPLICABLE RECEIPTS TOTALLING \$150 (or more) TO ncsa.fundraising@ncsaswim.ca Include your Account & Swimmer(s) Names and subject line "Bottle Drive Bond Receipts" to ensure the donation is applied to your account for the missed drive(s). Receipts MUST be received by MAY 31st 2025 to avoid being charged the \$150 bond per missed drive.

This week please watch for an email from me with the committee description with all members copied.


Some committees will have a lead already appointed, other committees will require someone to take the lead.
